Gorbenko N. I. graduated with honors from O. M. Gorky Kharkiv State University with diploma in biochemistry.

In 1993 she defended Candidate of Sciences thesis at the specialized academic council of the All-Russian Scientific Center for the Safety of Bioactive Substances. Nostrification of the degree of Candidate of Sciences was held in the specialized academic council of the Institute of Pharmacology and Toxicology of the AMS of Ukraine.

In 1997 Gorbenko N. I. received the scientific title of Senior Researcher in the specialty 14.00.25 – pharmacology.

The defend of doctoral dissertation in 2004 was held in the specialized academic council of the SI “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the NAMS of Ukraine”.

The academic title of Professor in the specialty 14.01.14 – endocrinology was received in 2014.

– member of the commission of the SI “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the NAMS of Ukraine” on entrance examinations to postgraduate studies and candidate exams in specialty 14.01.14 – endocrinology;

– member of 2 specialized academic councils in specialty 14.01.14 – endocrinology: D 64.564.01 in the SI “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the NAMS of Ukraine” and D 26.558.01 in the SI “V. P. Komisarenko Institute of Endocrinology and Metabolism of the NAMS of Ukraine”.

Since 2011, Gorbenko N. I. has been the head of the Research Center for Preclinical Drug Study, which was established at the SI “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the NAMS of Ukraine”.

Since 1994, Gorbenko N. I. has been a full member of the European Diabetes Study Association, as well as the Association of Pharmacologists of Ukraine and the Ukrainian Biochemical Society.

To date, Gorbenko N. I. is a member of the editorial board of the journal “Problems of Endocrine Pathology”.

Prof. Gorbenko is the author and co-author of 322 scientific publications, including 11 educational-practical works (2 monographs, 5 methodical recommendations, 4 lectures in manuals), 21 patents (10 of them for invention), 76 articles (13 in foreign editions) and 210 conference theses, including 69 abroad.

Gorbenko N. I. has repeatedly reported at international forums on endocrinology and pharmacology, in particular, at the EASD Annual Meetings (Copenhagen, Denmark, 2006; Amsterdam, The Netherlands, 2007; Vienna, Austria, 2009), D&CVD EASD Study Group Annual Meetings (Munich, Germany, 2011; Prague, Czech Republic, 2013; Milan, Italy, 2014; Munich, Germany, 2015; Paris, France, 2016) and CVOT Summits (Munich, Germany, 2017, 2019).

In 2005 and 2007 Gorbenko N. I. received the diploma of the first V. Ya. Danilevsky prize winner, in 2019 – the second prize for the best work presented at the Danilevsky readings; in 2005 and 2013 Prof. Gorbenko was awarded with Certificate of Honor of the Presidium of the NAMS of Ukraine.

In total, Gorbenko N. I. has participated in about 150 national and 60 international scientific conferences, congresses and symposia.
